Recent exhibition venues include Eyebeam in New York, The White Building in London, the Digital Arts Festival in Athens, and Galerie Charlot in Paris. Grosser's artworks have been featured in Wired, The Atlantic, The Guardian, Neural, El País, Der Spiegel, and Le Monde. His recognitions include First Prize in VIDA 16, and the Expanded Media Award for Network Culture from the Stuttgarter Filmwinter.
